There is not a giant mole living at the front of the school, we have instead got Earth Trust booked in to create an allotment area at the end of the month where each class will have a chance to grow vegetables.




OXFORD HIGH SCHOOL

You either book wraparound (if you are staying post 4.30) or you book a club (if you are staying until 4.30)


If you book 'wraparound' you can join the clubs if they aren't full.
