As the nights creep in on us, we look towards Advent and all the joy that the season will bring in school. It feels like we are in full flow now and our new children and families have all settled in, are working hard and are making friends.

Cradle to Career

I have been working closely with the other Blackbird Leys and Rosehill headteachers to build a partnership through a programme called Cradle to Career which will look at how we can work together to support families in the community with unity, rather than as individual schools.

It has also made us reflect inward on our role in the community; a massive thankyou to those who have agreed to be interviewed to support this project.

Reception and Nursery Places

We are currently touring families for children due to start Reception in September 2026., applications are open, so we strongly advise you to apply on time if you are a current nursery child – and if you know of anyone who is interested, please inform them of open mornings on November 19th and December 3rd. Last year our Reception class was oversubscribed, so it is vital applications are in on time.

This summer we extended our nursery to 32 places in each session, and in January we will be almost completely full, with only a handful of afternoon places available. If you know of anyone whose child has just turned 3, or is about to, and is looking for a nursery place, please ask them to get in touch as soon as possible.
