School Uniform Expectations (from September) – Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform each day. If children come to school wearing incorrect uniform, they will be given some of our Second-Hand uniform to wear – which must be handed back at the end of each day.

St Nicholas NURSERY (am) SCHOOL UNIFORM

Red Sweatshirt (Plain - no logo or one with school logo) - skirt, trousers, shorts

NO Jewellery or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn and must be taped over

St Therese (RECEPTION) SCHOOL UNIFORM

Red School Sweatshirt with logo or a plain red jumper from any retailer – grey/black skirt, trousers or shorts

NO Jewellery or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn but must be taped over.

YEARS 1 to 6 SCHOOL UNIFORM

Red School Sweatshirt with logo/**Red** cardigan *Plain non-logo jumper/cardigan is also acceptable*

White shirt/blouse/polo shirt

Black or Grey trousers/tailored shorts. Black leggings - NO TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS

Black or Grey pinafores/skirts Red and White Gingham skirts and dresses can be worn in the Summer

Black or Grey socks
Black/Grey tights or white ankle or knee-high socks
if wearing a dress

Black school shoes or all black trainers (trainers must be completely black – not with different coloured soles or branded logos on them

NO Jewellery (except for a small crucifix necklace) or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn – but must be taped over.

NO Make up to be worn - If a pupil wishes to use make up to cover e.g. scarring, then an agreement must be made on an individual basis with the Headteacher.

Long hair must be tied back

Please bring in a named bag of spare clothes to keep in school as sometimes pupils may get wet or muddy.

A pair of wellies for outdoor play and a pair of plimsolls for indoors should shoes get wet or muddy.

Please bring a PE Kit in a separate bag each week – the PE Kit will be the same as below.

YEARS 1 to 6 PE/GAMES KIT

Physical Education is an important part of your child's curriculum, and it is vital that your child wears the appropriate kit for each of their planned sessions. PE kit should be worn to school on the days that PE is being taught for your child's class.

For indoor PE sessions, children should wear

- A red T-Shirt or polo shirt
- Black shorts
- Black plimsolls

For **outdoor** PE sessions, children may wear

- a red T-Shirt or polo shirt
- Black shorts or jogging bottoms no branding
- Red or Black sweatshirt/hoodie no branding
- Trainers

*Year 6 School Leavers' Hoodies are acceptable – but only if red

Long hair must be tied back
