School Uniform Expectations (from September) – Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform each day. If children come to school wearing incorrect uniform, they will be given some of our Second-Hand uniform to wear – which must be handed back at the end of each day.

St Nicholas NURSERY (am) SCHOOL UNIFORM Red Sweatshirt (Plain - no logo or one with school logo) - skirt, trousers, shorts NO Jewellery or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn and must be taped over	
St Therese (RECEPTION) SCHOOL UNIFORM Red School Sweatshirt with logo - skirt, trousers, shorts NO Jewellery or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn but must be taped over. <i>Plain non-logo jumper/cardigan is also acceptable</i>	Please bring in a named bag of spare clothes to keep in school as sometimes pupils may get wet or muddy. A pair of wellies for outdoor play and a pair of plimsolls for indoors should shoes get wet or muddy. Please bring a PE Kit in a separate bag each week – the PE Kit will be the same as below.
YEARS 1 to 6 SCHOOL UNIFORM Red School Sweatshirt with logo/ Red cardigan <i>Plain non-logo jumper/cardigan is also acceptable</i> White shirt/blouse/polo shirt Black/Grey trousers/tailored shorts/leggings - NO TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS Grey pinafores/skirts Red and White Gingham skirts and dresses can be worn in the Summer Black/Grey socks - white ankle or knee-high socks - black/grey/plain tights Black school shoes or all black trainers (trainers must be completely black – not with different coloured soles or branded logos on them) NO Jewellery (except for a small crucifix necklace) or earrings (only freshly pierced with small studs for first 6 weeks only) to be worn – but must be taped over. NO Make up to be worn - If a pupil wishes to use make up to cover e.g. scarring, then an agreement must be made on an individual basis with the Headteacher. Long hair must be tied back	YEARS 1 to 6 PE/GAMES KIT Physical Education is an important part of your child's curriculum, and it is vital that your child wears the appropriate kit for each of their planned sessions. <i>PE kit should be worn to school on the days that PE is being taught for your child's class.</i> For indoor PE sessions, children should wear <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A red T-Shirt or polo shirt • Black shorts • Black plimsolls For outdoor PE sessions, children may wear <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a red T-Shirt or polo shirt • Black jogging bottoms – no branding • Black sweatshirt/hoodie - no branding • Trainers *Year 6 School Leavers' Hoodies are acceptable – but only if red Long hair must be tied back
