Home Learning



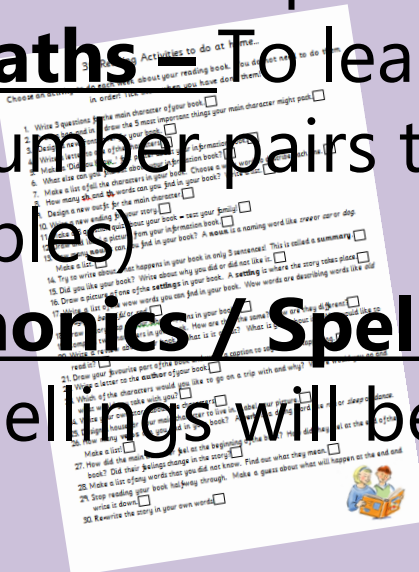
Reading Record Books For parents to record when they have read with their child.

Fastening and unfastening coats

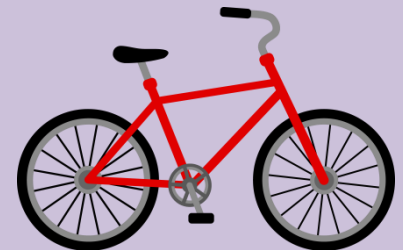
