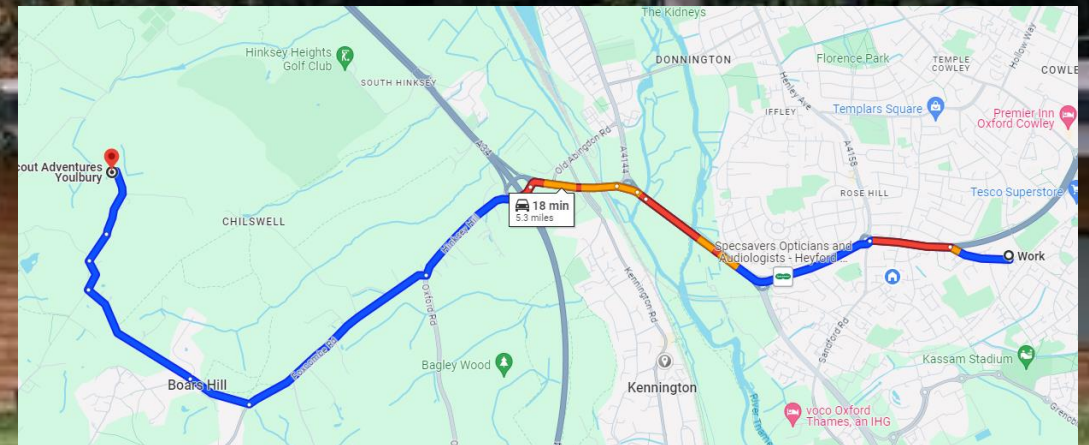
Where they are going

What to bring

Contact

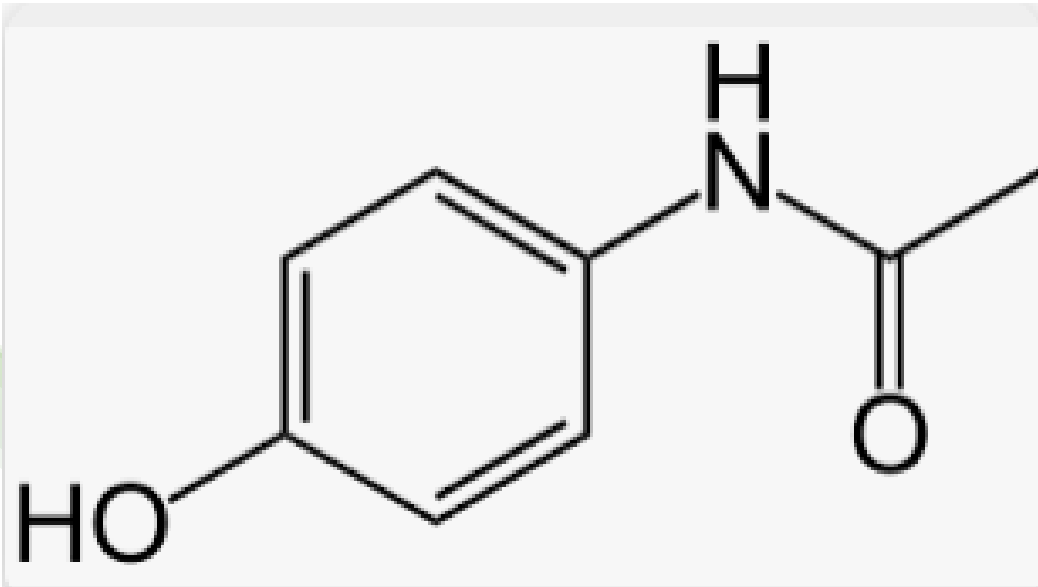
- We will have a mobile phone, the number will be shared with all families
- Please only contact us in an emergency – If it is during school time, the school office should be your first point of contact
- Your child will not be bringing any mobile phones or smart tech with them.



Behaviour

- Youlbury is extremely close, but if we feel a child is not being safe – this will mostly be in regards to refusing to follow instructions, we will contact you to collect them.
- If you can't be contacted, a member of staff will bring them back to school.
- This would be a last resort, but the safety of the other children and staff is paramount, and we are one adult to a group, so a child refusing to participate removes the group from an activity.

Medical forms / Allergies



- Medical consent forms will be sent out – we can give out medicines, but we need to have it all recorded clearly
- Please can we have labelled medicine in a clear bag given to us the morning of the trip.
- We should already know about any allergies, and this will be passed on – if we don't: please let us know.

PAY

- If you do not pay in full before departure, your child will not go, even if they are here with their bags.
- We will still have to pay for the place, so please talk to us now if there is a problem
